At the inception of the project (2010), she registered with only 7 (seven) goats. She took keen interest on the various training cum awareness programmes and adopted the scientific technologies for Goat farming. She devoted herself for improving the nutritional habit, housing system of the goats and participated in every treatment cum vaccination camps organized by the project. "AICRP on Goat Improvement has changed my life considerably. I never took Goat farming seriously and doing it just for the sake of rearing few goats. The number of goats always restricted to 6-8 numbers before", says Rina, who once was very much frustrated due to frequent occurrence of diseases and parasitic infestation in goats.



The AICRP on Goat Improvement has been playing a very decisive role in her goatery and helped her lot to improve her financial condition. Under the project, she has been receiving



all the necessary veterinary cares viz. treatment, vaccination, feed etc. for her goats together with elite breeding buck for healthier future progeny. As a beneficiary of the project, Mrs. Medhi has participated in various training programs encompassing different aspects of goatery development which has upgraded her technical know-how in goat rearing. With all the knowledge

and technical support from the project, her goatery has boomed from an infant stage to a presently flourished condition.

At the start of the project, the annual income of Rina from goat was a meager Rs.4,000.00 which has now increased to a respectable amount of Rs. 19,900.00 by selling 7 (seven) goats. She is very proud of her goatery which comprises of 44 goats and she is successfully managing some of the household expenses along with the education of her children.
