Smt. Thresiamma Johnson, age- 49, housewife, resides at Eruveshi panchayat of Kannur district possess 2.00 hectors' of land. Her family consists of her husband (an agricultural farmer) and two sons (Jothish- driver, Sudesh- graduate student). She started goat farming a five years and at present her goat shed contains twenty five Malabari goats including 15 adult female, 10 kids and a superior quality breeding bucks. First she started rearing with two goats and with the knowledge gained from her experience encouraged her to expand her farm. Smt. Thresiamma Johnson's family possesses 2.00 hectares of fertile agricultural field which possess coconut, cashew, black pepper cultivation and posse's large quantity of tree fodder. They cultivated fodder in their land around 1 acres of CO3 and mostly use tree foddors such as jack leafs in their field. She adopted scientific breeding practices like rotation of bucks every two years, preservation of dried jack leaves by sprinkling two percentage salt solutions. Smt. Thresiamma Johnson sell around 5-7 kids in a year, Urine and dung used in their field.
